



- Mentoring by those who have been there














The county and commercial partners both have space that can provide a fertile place for you to grow your startup—and offer flexible services and lease terms:

Network


With annual, monthly or ad hoc events, Montgomery County offers opportunities to meet with others who can help you improve your business model.




Funding
